

**21<sup>st</sup> ANNUAL MEETING OF THE

Reis Biological Station

Meeting Date: September 27-28, 2008

Place: Reis Biological Station, 11 miles east of Steelville on Hwy 8 in Crawford County (see below).

Accommodations: Dormitory, sleeping cabins (3 or 4 persons per cabin) and tent camping sites are available. Bring pillow, sleeping bag or bedding.

Food: This year we will again have a POTLUCK for the Saturday evening dinner. Please bring a hot dish, salad, chips, dessert, hot rolls, chicken wings, etc. Supply your own drinks and tableware for dinner.

Saturday Paper Session: Starts at 1:00 p.m., Saturday, September 28. Members planning to present a paper should fill out and return the attached registration form to Jeff Briggler no later than **September 15, 2008**.

Saturday Evening Event: Bob Powell will present an after dinner slide show of the herps from his travels. Fellowship, musical entertainment (bring instruments), and telling tall tales will follow the Bob's presentation.

Sunday: A morning field trip is planned from 9:00 - noon.

**Directions to Reis Biological Station:** At Cuba, Missouri (on I-44) take MO 19 south to Steelville. Proceed through Steelville on the main road (combined MO 8/MO 19). At the eastern edge of Steelville take MO 8 toward Potosi for 11 miles. (MO 19 turns south at this point).

After leaving Steelville you will cross Huzzah Creek (approximately 8.0 miles east of Steelville). Continue on Highway 8 up the long hill for 3.0 miles. At the top of the hill is a blue highway sign that reads "Roadside Park ½ mile". The gravel road to the station is the first road to the right after the sign (about two blocks distance). Take the gravel road for approximately 1.5 miles to the station. You will know that you missed the entrance if you reach the roadside park on the left. If you do, turn around and go back to the first road.
